
CLEARING AND GRUBBING ACTIVITIES ARE STARTING SOON

Carolina Crossroads Phase 3B

As part of the Carolina Crossroads Project, clearing and grubbing activities are anticipated to start in December 2024. This work is necessary to prepare the area for upcoming utility relocations and involves removing trees and underbrush within the project area. This work does **NOT** include major construction on the cloverleaf, identified as Phase 3A.

A key benefit of this construction phase is improved sightlines, which will enhance safety and visibility for drivers.














Phase 3B Scope:

Clearing and grubbing approximately 170 acres across the I-20/26 and I-26/126 system interchanges, St. Andrews Road at I-26, and Bush River Road at I-20.

Location:

Includes I-26 westbound (Bush River Rd to Beatty Rd) and eastbound (Tram Rd) as well as the cloverleaves at the I-20/I-26 interchange.

Work Hours

Daytime operations; minor delays possible on frontage roads due to flagging.

Timeline:

Work begins December 2024, ending late 2025 or early 2026.
