


# CLEARING AND GRUBBING ACTIVITIES ARE STARTING SOON




## Carolina Crossroads Phase 3B

As part of the Carolina Crossroads Project, clearing and grubbing activities are anticipated to start in December 2024. This work is necessary to prepare the area for upcoming utility relocations and involves removing trees and underbrush within the project area. This work does **NOT** include major construction on the I-20/I-26 interchange (cloverleaf), identified as Phase 3E.

A key benefit of this construction phase is improved sightlines, which will enhance safety and visibility for drivers.

### Phase 3B Scope:

Clearing and grubbing approximately 170 acres across the I-20/I-26, St. Andrews Road/I-26, and Bush River Road/I-20 interchanges.

### Location:

This work covers I-20 in both directions, from the Phase 2 connection to the Bush River Road/I-20 interchange.

### Work Hours:


Majority of the work will be conducted during daytime hours; however, temporary lane closures may occur during nighttime operations.

### Timeline:

Work begins December 2024, ending late 2025 or early 2026.

### Increased Activity:

You may notice equipment and trucks throughout the project area.
