SCDOT to temporarily close I-20 Westbound ramp to I-26 Westbound in Richland County as part of Carolina Crossroads Project Construction

Columbia, S.C. (October 20, 2025) - The South Carolina Department of Transportation will temporarily close the I-20 Westbound ramp to I-26 Westbound (Exit 64B) beginning October 22 at 11 p.m. This closure is expected to last until 5 a.m. on October 23.

This temporary closure will allow crews to complete construction activities related to the [Carolina Crossroads Project](#).

Drivers traveling from I-20 Westbound to I-26 Westbound will continue along I-20 Westbound and take Exit 64A to I-26 Eastbound, then take Exit 107B to I-20 Eastbound, and exit at 64B to I-26 Westbound. Detour signs will alert drivers to these changes.

SCDOT asks that drivers slow down and pay attention when driving near a work zone.
