## **SCDOT to conduct nighttime detour of I-126 Westbound ramp to I-26 Eastbound for Carolina Crossroads Project**


**Columbia, S.C.** (August 20, 2025) – The South Carolina Department of Transportation will conduct a temporary nighttime closure of the I-126 Westbound ramp to I-26 Eastbound and the Colonial Life Blvd to I-26 Eastbound. This closure is necessary to replace and update overhead signage. This work is scheduled to take place on Wednesday, Aug. 20, between 8 p.m. and 6 a.m., weather permitting.

Traffic will be detoured to the I-26/I-20 interchange. Drivers will follow the detour signs from I-26 Westbound to the I-20 Westbound ramp and then will need to use the exit to I-26 Eastbound toward Charleston. A map of the closure and detour can be found below.

SCDOT asks drivers to slow down and pay attention to crews and signs when driving near work zones.
